The Journey is a recovery support community for teens aimed to help them live a successful and drug free lifestyle. Through their time in The Journey, teens will gain the discipline, knowledge, and skills needed to make informed choices that will shape and mold their future to a better, more drug free, way of life.

Membership Requirements:

- A commitment to be drug free
- Mental Health/Substance Use Evaluation*
- 13-17 years of age
- History of minor to severe substance use in the last 6 months
- Completed Substance Use Treatment program or referred by a counselor*

There are 3 Pathways Available

The Traditional*

A 6 month path that offers the **most exposure to, support from, and accountability with our recovery support community**. Members participate at least 3 days each week and weekend social events for six months. Members will have access to all educational, life skills, and fun weekend social events.

Inner Healing*

The Inner Healing Course **is a faith based course, taught at The Journey, that focuses on deeply rooted pain and trauma**. This 4 month path enables members to engage in the Inner Healing Course at least 2 days a week and fun weekend social events.

**Parental consent and the member's commitment to enroll in this Inner Healing course is required.*

First Steps

This 3 month path is ideal for teens with a **history of minor substance abuse (1-2 occasions)** in the past six months. First Steps offers drug education classes and life skills groups at least 1 day each week and fun weekend social events for three months.
