- 1. Assist people in developing natural supports or friendships.
- 2. Assist people in being contributing members of their community.
- 3. Provide opportunities for greater choices and increase a person's control over their own life.



Developmental Services Disability Services

Employment & Community Services

Avita Community Partners helps adults with developmental disabilities participate in their communities and pursue their dreams.

Staff may provide personal, social, and community supports for personal self–care and household maintenance.

Training is provided to the staff on job caring and or matching. Person–centered service plans are reviewed with the staff as well as direct skills evidence based training.

Employment Program

Our Community Employment Program helps adults with developmental disabilities, mental illness, or substance addictions learn job skills. Our Employment Specialists help people identify their strengths, pursue interviews, and support them in succeeding at their job. Employment may be only a few hours per week and up to full–time employment.

Our staff work with a variety of employers to reflect the variety of interests of our clients. Avita Community Partners has helped place individuals in banks, hospitals, food service operations, retail sites, and manufacturing companies.

Residential Services

Our *Residential Services* assist individuals live in their own home, with a host family or in a group home. For individuals living in their own residences, Avita employees assist with activities such as shopping, paying bills, and cooking. For person living with a host family or at a group home, 24—hour support is provided.

- <u>Community Access Services</u> provides opportunities and support that enable individuals to participate in a variety of community life experiences and to optimize independent living skills.
- *Host Home Providers are provided by caring families who welcome persons with a developmental disability into their home and support him or her with care, dignity, and respect and provide a safe living environment.
- <u>Respite Services</u> are individuals or families who can give short-term relief to families members and other caretaker who need a break by caring for their loved ones with special needs on a temporary basis.
- <u>Family Support Services</u> assist families in obtaining specialized medical supplies, equipment, and other assistance that focuses on helping families with difficulties.
- * Host Home Families and clients are matched according to likes and similar ideals. All host homes receive monthly review to ensure the homes are safe and the needs of the clients are met. Host Home Families receive training in health and safety, implementation of service plans, and person-centered services.

Community Integration

Clients choose activities that will enable them to gain independence with their personal goals. Many of the services are offered in the community to assist in creating natural supports. If a client does not know what


