

Our Program

Members will be separated into two developmentally appropriate age groups: 7-10 year olds and 11-14 year olds.

- 7-10 years old meet on Tuesday and Thursdays.
- 11-14 year olds meet on Wednesdays and Fridays.
- The groups will alternate Saturdays.
- One Saturday a month, each group wil go on a field trip.
- On their second Saturday, each group will host a *Parent Support Day*.

Rabun Clubhouse is a home away from home for children and adolescents, giving them a variety of opportunities to work on social and independent living skills in a safe and nurturing environment.
